### **B) Special camping activities:**

The college organizes a seven-day residential special camp for volunteers. During the last three years, the college organized camps in the adopted village-Kolwadi (Ale).

National Service Scheme (NSS) student volunteers for promoting state and central government schemes like 'Betibachao, betipadhao', 'Swachh Bharat Abhiyan' tracing out-of-school children or school dropouts, raising digital awareness, tying up with Paani Foundation or Naam Foundation with a view to raising awareness on water conservation. The N.S.S. Programme officers and the volunteers with help of villagers implemented activities like cleanliness, water conservation, tree –plantation, village social survey, health camps, cultural activities.

The NSS is a voluntary association of young people in colleges, universities and at the plus two level. The students get incentive marks in their academics for participating in NSS programmes.

This academic year 250 student volunteers enrolled for NSS. Numerous activities were carried out by them during this period such as Tree plantation, International Yoga Day, Blood donation camp, Road Safety Programme, Essay Writing Competition, Swachh Bharat Abhiyan at Shri Kshetra Lenyadri, adopted village Kolwadi and College campus on large scale. Apart from this special camp was organized at Kolwadi and volunteers from our NSS wing were participated in University level camps at many other places. As a 'Shramdan' (Labour Donation), volunteers offered their services in construction of dam, cleaning the various campuses as College campus, Kolwadi campus, Sant Dnyaneshwar Maharaj Temple ( *Reda Samadhi*), *Ale Dudh Utpadak Sanstha*, *Zilha Parishad* Primary School campus at the village kolwadi.
